COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

PLEASE NOTE: Class sizes are limited to 6 students per class

CARTOONING, ANIME & COMICS: This class begins with a quick introduction on how to draw the human body, then into proportions, body shapes, facial expressions, adding movement, and onto character design. Students will have the opportunity to create their own wire form figure (which they will draw from), as well as designing their own character, and learning techniques cartoonists and illustrators use for highlighting and shading.

PINATAS: Discover the history of pinatas, while learning how to construct 3 different varieties of pinatas. In this workshop, students will learn how to build different infrastructures, create forms, and learn different techniques for decorating a variety of pinatas. The final project is to design & construct your own full size pinata.

WOOD & METAL: In this workshop students will have the opportunity to work in both metal and wood, in creating custom designed and personalized projects. Students will gain knowledge of different woodworking skills and techniques, as well as metal forming techniques, such as chise & repousse. For one of the projects students will also have the opportunity to use a plasma cutter (under adult supervision and guidance) to further expand their creative explorations.

SPECIAL NOTE: Students are required to wear pants, and close toed shoes for this workshop...no exceptions.

PRINTMAKING: This workshop has been designed to teach different techniques and styles of printmaking. Throughout the week, students will explore Lithographs, Collagraphs, Gytaku, Relief, and monoprints. Students will create custom prints, cards, and have the opportunity to print their creation onto wood too!

SCULPTURES: Work both in the studio and outdoors using metal, wood, paint, wire, foam, and various other materials. Students will learn how to create both subtractive and additive sculptures, free form and practice going from a 2-D idea or drawing into a 3-D form and sculpture.

CHILD CARE: This class is available for parents who need extended child care. Students will eat their lunch (brought from home) and have the opportunity to finish any project they might need extra time on. Art & Craft supplies will be made available, or students can use the time to play in the yard, or work in the garden.
